1. TOLL FREE TELEPHONE SUPPORT

The Caregivers Network for East Kootenay Seniors provides toll free telephone support throughout the East Kootenay for caregivers caring for seniors. A caregiver may be a spouse, daughter, son, neighbour or friend.

- Through the toll free line we provide emotional support, debriefing and day to day coping strategies for caregivers.
- Resource information about each community.
- Access to caregiver information from our library database.
- Referrals to our facilitators and support group information throughout the East Kootenay.

2. SUPPORT GROUPS

The Caregivers Network for East Kootenay Seniors provides monthly support groups in Cranbrook, Creston, Fernie, Golden, Invermere, and Kimberley. Our support groups provide a safe and nonjudgmental place for caregivers to:

- Rediscover the joys of caring for a loved one.
- Exchange information about what to do, where to go and whom to call.
- Exchange practical ideas and share experiences.
- Explore coping strategies to deal with feelings of anger, frustration, guilt, isolation, helplessness and hopelessness that many caregivers feel.
- Reduce the isolation felt by caregivers by coming together in a supportive environment.
- Offer education and tips for caregivers.
- Identify and support the needs that are unique to caregivers of seniors.
