WHAT WE DO



1. TOLL FREE TELEPHONE SUPPORT

The Caregivers Network for East Kootenay Seniors provides toll free telephone support throughout the East Kootenay for family caregivers caring for seniors with higher complex needs.

- Through the toll free line we provide emotional support, debriefing and day to day coping strategies for caregivers.
- Resource information about each community.
- Access to caregiver information from our library database.
- Referrals to our facilitators and support group information throughout the East Kootenay.

3. IN-PERSON SUPPORT VISITS

- Offer emotional support and coping strategies.
- One on one caregiver coaching to help caregivers make a plan and access the correct information.
- Offer links to community resources and support available for caregivers.

2. SUPPORT GROUPS

The Caregivers Network for East Kootenay Seniors provides support groups in Cranbrook, Creston, Fernie, Golden, Invermere, and Kimberley. Our support groups provide a safe and nonjudgmental place for caregivers to:

- Exchange information about what to do, where to go and whom to call.
- Exchange practical ideas and share experiences.
- Explore coping strategies to deal with feelings of anger, frustration, guilt, isolation, helplessness and hopelessness that many caregivers feel.
- Reduce the isolation felt by caregivers by coming together in a supportive environment.
- Identify and support the needs that are unique to caregivers of seniors.

4. EDUCATION AND ADVOCACY

- Access to our extensive DVD Library on caregiving.
- Books, articles and print material on being a caregiver.
- Information and education to community partners about issues caregivers face.
- Education and learning seminars for caregivers in our region.
- Online resources and events to keep caregivers connected and informed.
